





Old Business: The Minutes of the July meeting were briefly reviewed and approved.

#### **New Business:**

**Treasurer Report:** John Falco reported: As of September 15, the club had \$7,439.85 in checking/savings accounts. All outstanding bills had been paid as of 09-15-2016.

**Membership:** Steve Handler reported that the club now has 104 dues paying members.

**Advertising:** Steve Handler gave a brief synopsis of our advertisers who have paid for space in JAGWire. **Old Business:** The Minutes of the September meeting were briefly reviewed and approved. Secretary Steve Handler reiterated that only items/issues that were actually discussed can be included in the club minutes. No 'add-ons' will be included unless they were part of issues deliberated at the meeting.

#### **New Business:**


#### CLOSING A CHAPTER TO START THE NEXT: 1959 XK150S FHC REBUILD

While watching the 2015 Monaco Grand Prix on TV, I had a revelation. We would sell our 1958 XK150S OTS (Open Two Seater). I found a 1959 XK150S Fixed Head Coupe (FHC) for sale on the internet. Jaguar produced a total of 4447 XK150 FHC. Only 350 XK150 FHC were constructed in the "S" configuration and, of those, only 87 were exported to the USA.



I bought the FHC sight unseen. It was a leap of faith. The car, originally from California, was located in Colorado. We shipped it directly to J. K. Restorations in



The FHC was straight, original, complete, and almost rust free. But it was not running. It needed new

paint, and the interior was trash. When a friend of Liza's saw the pictures taken that day she could not understand why we would "buy a car like that." We explained that it is a perfect car for a comprehensive restoration and an opportunity to acquire a car that would meet our future Jaguar needs.

A little over a year later we are ready to open the next Chapter. Our OTS is on display at the Fantasy Junction show room in the San Francisco Bay area and the restoration of the FHC is almost complete.

Liza and I are eager to hook up our trailer to our Range Rover, travel to Illinois,



test drive the car, load it on the trailer, and bring it home in time to compete in the last Jaguar Clubs of North America Concours of the year to be held on November 19, 2016 by the Jaguar Club of South West Florida. Phil Mannino, Concours Chair for JCOF in 2015, was instrumental in starting this new Club in the area he now calls his home. This will be their inaugural Concours d'Elegance.



Phil is the Chief Judge, so I have alerted him that I will be entering our XK150S FHC in the S2/Modified Class because it will be equipped with a number of items not considered authentic under JCNA Concours Rules; such as a Derrington wood rimmed steering wheel and Borrani polished alloy wire wheels.

After the Concours, the next planned foray for our newly restored car will be the December 3, JCOF "Bok to Bach" Tour to Bok Tower Gardens, Holiday House and Sunset Symphony in Lake Wales. Hope to see you there.









## Lake Mirror Classic Auto Festival

This was the 17th Annual Lake Mirror Classic, staged by JCOF member Ford Heacock and Heacock Classic Car Insurance. The Lake Mirror has grown to be counted among the finest classic and exotic car festivals in America – often included in conversations including Amelia Island and Pebble Beach. Few JCOF members were seen at this year's event, probably because of the hot day. What a shame! Though Jaguar was not the featured manufacturer this year, a number of historic and absolutely superb Jaguar automobiles highlighted the show.



Ford Heacock's own 1950 Mark V was pristine and elegant, though perhaps not as sporty as Bob Tullius' Group 44 racer which ran in the 1986 12 Hours of Sebring and the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

Did you ever think you would see a Jaguar worth up to \$10,000,000 (Million that is)? Well then, you didn't attend The Lake Mirror Classic. Only 12 Lightweight E-Types were produced and are now trading for almost the 'Big 10' figure.

Mark Tillis from Bellaire, FL displayed his 1963 which had been stripped to bare bodyshell before a full rotisserie restoration and painting in Ecure Blue.





Most JCNA members have heard of Dan Ligas – if only for the Sun Coast Jaguar Club of Florida's annual Concours d'Elegance which bears his name. Dan and brother Larry were enamored of all things Jaguar – especially the one-off prototype XJ13, developed in the mid 1960's but never raced or produced. In 1992 Dan, Larry and several friends flew to New

Jersey to photograph the 'real' XJ13 on display at Jaguar US headquarters. They secretly made hundreds of photographs and embarked on creating a full-scale reproduction; including over 700 hand-drilled rivet holes and a 5.3L Jaguar V12 mid-engine. WOW! What a privilege it was to see such a wonderful labor of love and recall one of the greatest supercars ever! And you weren't there? Tsk-Tsk-Tsk!

Concours competitive XK120s, XK140s, XK150s and classic Marks and XJs were among over 700 vehicles displayed around Lake Mirror and throughout downtown Lakeland. Tuxedoed waiters, led by a Scottish bagpiper, paraded down the promenade to deliver luncheon to judges and exhibitors. Classic Bikes, Boats and Motorcycles also earned awards.





Many exhibitors were period costumes and competed in the fashion show. Never one to be upstaged, JCOF member Ginger Corda was especially scintillating, while husband, Mike, (YEP, they made it legal), displayed





their 1966 Jaguar XK E-Type on its 'golden anniversary.' Ginger was to serve as Navigator for the world-famous Jaguar racing driver, Bob Tullius, in the Lake Mirror Classic Road Trip on Sunday. She has promised a full report and photos for the next edition of JAGWire.






As expected, the 2016 JCOF Summer Slalom turned out to be another fantastic event. Tom Wright, Jefferson Wheeler and a handful of volunteers laid out a precise JCNA slalom course and made sure that the electronic timing system was up and running smoothly. Bob Lewis volunteered to keep the time sheet for all of the entrants and deserves special thanks for sitting in the hot sun for nearly four hours tracking progress of each driver.













And, of course, there was the JCNA mandated tech inspection run expertly by Tom Wright III. Although one or two fierce competitors left a few pylons turned upside down, none of the competing cars were damaged.

This was an 'Open Slalom' which meant that any registered driver could compete in any car. Three non-Jaguar cars and one modified E-Type as well as seven regular 'Cats' were entered. Of the three non-Jag cars, Dianna Bogdany's beautiful new white Corvette really stood out. Her time of 45.436 seconds was good enough to beat five of her male competitors, including her husband's time in their E-Type 2+2. So take that, guys!







Our own 'Rocket Man', Ian Crawford, was able to start his E-Type Green Rocket and post a time of 40.958 seconds. That might be the fastest time this year in JCNA! Ian earned "Silver" and ranked second in North America in both Jaguar and non-Jaguar categories in 2015. 
