• Joe Dechristofaro from Archer. He'll be in the market for a new Jaguar soon.



Throughout the year scores are submitted to JCNA for ranking of the Top Three in each Jaguar car's year/model classification. JCOF often ranks far above most other clubs and 2016 was no exception. JCOF sponsors a Summer Slalom and works with Jaguar Car Club of North Florida (JCCNF) for a Winter Slalom. For those who are not familiar with how a Slalom is set up and scored, pylons are arranged to form a very tight race track. Speeds seldom exceed 35-40 mph and the drivers with the shortest/fastest times win in their car's respective JCNA classification.

**Ian Crawford** won **1**<sup>st</sup> **place** in Class 'H' in his E-Type Green Rocket. Ian's need for speed resulted in a remarkable 40.958 seconds, *fastest Slalom time in North America in 2016.* We're hoping to have a special article about Ian's Green Rocket in a future edition of JAGWire.

Competitors in almost every JCOF event, **Danny and Dianna Bogdany** drove their 12 cylinder 1971 E-Type 2+2 Coupe to earn **3<sup>rd</sup> place in North America 'E' Class** with a Slalom time of 49.06 seconds.

At our Winter Slalom, JCCNF's **Ian Massey** earned **1**<sup>st</sup> **place in North America Class 'L'**, maneuvering his #13 XKR-S through the pylons in just 42.773 seconds. In Class 'P', **Juan Sierra** ranked **2<sup>nd</sup> place in North America** with a time in the Winter Slalom of 51.140 seconds in his 2011 XK Convertible.




