After receiving explicit instructions and being led on walking tours of the tight slalom course, drivers were ready to put on their helmets and test their driving and their cars' abilities and skills.

As if Saturday's Slalom wasn't enough fun for the day, Ian Crawford invited everyone to his family's summer home on Lake Harris for a Freeloaders Lunch! A visit to Ian's garage would have been a delightful treat alone, but to share gracious hospitality and sumptuous food in a gorgeous home? My-O-My!

No one dared guess the value of the cars in Ian's garage. There were two of only 271 Jaguar XJ220s built from 1991-1994. "The Fastest Car in the World" in the 1990s got up to 27 mpg. (Gas mileage must have been an important factor for purchasers of a \$750,000+ Jaguar in the early '90s).



With prior year records as the *Fastest Slalom Car in JCNA*, Ian's 1971 Series II E-Type 'Green Rocket' was quite at home in this garage. Much prettier is his Blue Series III E-Type that he's been restoring in the past fifteen years. Hmmmm. Which car in this garage might be the fastest 0-60? Any of four Jaguars? The Porshe GT3? The Ferrari? Chances are the fastest 0-60 would be his Tesla Model S, left sitting in the driveway.



Several Crawford neighbors joined us for the Freeloaders Lunch. It was the first time for some to see the fantastic cars up close. Someone noticed numerous plaques and awards on display. Of special interest was the JCNA Newsletter Award for Ian's article and wife Hazel's photographs of Jaguars (Big Cats, not cars) made on their adventurous trip down the Amazon River in Brazil. Sometimes, I am glad that I am bold [an understatement]. I asked Ian Callum to draw a car for me, and wow...he did! That treasured art lives in my safe. He sketched it in 2005 in the Chateau Elan lounge over drinks, on a poster of the just-debuted Advanced Lightweight Coupe concept car that we had just gotten from the Championship Challenge meet in Braselton, Georgia.

For JCOF, it was a big road trip to Georgia near Road Atlanta. Mike and I drove the 1971 V12 E-Type up with friends from the south Florida club in another V12 E, along with John & Rocco Falco and Tom Curren trailering John's freshly restored E-Type. The Florida clubs had quite a contingency that year – I remember well the photos we took with our E-Types and the 1935 SS II Tourer in front, long before it was mine. What a blast we had. Mr. Ian Callum was our featured Jaguar guest that year. Brilliant, talented man. Minimalist almost - loved clean designs.

So, after a few drinks, with a borrowed pen, on 'fan demand,' he chose a place on the ad, and he created this really cool sketch right above the printed word, "concept" on the post. We enjoyed watching him at work – his artful pen strokes – as he explained which lines he starts with. Ian can't sketch without design, and he gave particular attention to the higher doors and narrowed "eye" window shape. He then surprised me by ending with a sharp front, and back -- new stuff – Including bigger wheels. He loved the bigger wheels.

I was very impressed, to say the least. It only took him a minute...just a sketch. A doodle. And then he signed it with a big Sharpie marker as a

keepsake. Great memories. Wonderful stuff. We had a nice chat about the prospects of anything like the E-Type ever being built again. Just looked at the sketch again now, and it slightly resembles the current F-Type. Hmm

Coventry Foundation Preserving Jaguar[®] History

Recently, George Camp, received a magnificent donation from Jim Stockton of his Jaguar MK2, and transported it back to the Coventry Foundation Library/Research Center in Columbia, SC. This great example will become part of the Foundation collection and be available for view, and research at the library. This particular example of the MK2 is a very early one. It is 55th MK2 built, and has a 3.4L motor. These early ones were typically ordered in Japan, and in this case we have not yet determined where it was originally delivered. It is thru the generosity of folks like Jim, that the Foundation has grown rapidly over the past few years in our mission to serve the enthusiast community in North America.

The Coventry Foundation (Foundation) is a not for profit charitable corporation created to perpetuate the heritage of Jaguar[®] Cars in North America filling a role analogous to that of the Jaguar Daimler Heritage Trust. The Foundation's mission is to serve the needs of Jaguar[®] enthusiasts throughout North America on the belief that these wonderful cars should be enjoyed, driven, raced, and shared with the public to encourage the involvement of people of all ages in the appreciation of Jaguars[®]. Although relatively new, the Foundation has been making great progress in expanding beyond the scope of Jaguar[®] Cars and Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA). The Foundation is separate from those organizations (as required by USA law for charitable organizations) but it works closely with both pursuant to agreements where their interests and missions overlap.

The Foundation has established a Library in Columbia, South Carolina well stocked with historic and technical books to serve as a resource for historical information related to the restoration and repair of Jaguar[®] Cars. The Foundation also provides information and copies of out of print documents. These materials are available by appointment to Patrons of the Foundation desiring to research their favorite Jaguar[®].

The Foundation has a display area in the British Sports Car Hall of Fame at the Moss Facility in Petersburg, Virginia and is working towards finding a second library/ display location on the West Coast. The next major step will be a permanent Museum location where the Foundation's functions can be consolidated and its collections displayed and opened to Jaguar[®] enthusiasts from around the World.

An endowed scholarship program at Penn Technical College for students in their accredited training program for the restoration of classic cars has been created by the Foundation. Additional scholarships are in the planning stage.

The Foundation's extensive collection of model cars, framed artwork, rare, original, and authentic Jaguar® artifacts, and classic Jaguar® Cars which includes an XK140 FHC, a Mark II Sedan, a Series III E-Type, and an early XJS are displayed at the Library in Columbia, SC and at the hall of Fame in Petersburg, VA.

The Founding Fathers of the Foundation are Gary Kincel (President) and George Camp (Secretary/Treasurer). Dick Maury, Gary Hagopian, and Tom Krefetz are Founding Board of Directors Members and Tom Wright has performed the legal work. All have filled important positions (Continued on page 5)






