JCNA INTERNATIONAL JAGUAR FESTIVAL 2021

Wednesday, October 20 - Sunday, October 24

Originally planned to be held in 2020, the IJF was delayed a full year till 2021. Some might say, "It took two full years to put this whole thing together!" After experiencing the multiplicity of details and how smoothly everything went, I doubt that anyone would argue.

Wife Judy, twin brother Charlie and I could not attend any of the five events on Wednesday or Thursday, but everyone with whom we talked raved about the fun they had. Wednesday's Sunset Dinner Cruise was overbooked early, but some folks canceled (given the option of being thrown overboard).

Earlier in the day, IJF Chief Judge and JCNA Southeast Regional Director, Craig Kerins, gave final instructions to the 36 JCNA Certified and Apprentice Judges.



Judges then divided into 12 teams, pledged to follow JCNA's strict concours guidelines.

With a maximum limit of 15 minutes per car, they then scrutinized and scored 65 near-perfect Jaguars in 3 1/2 hours.



JCNA Chief Judge, Hal Kritzman, noted that this was the largest and most eminent list of judges ever assembled for a JCNA Concours d'Elegance.

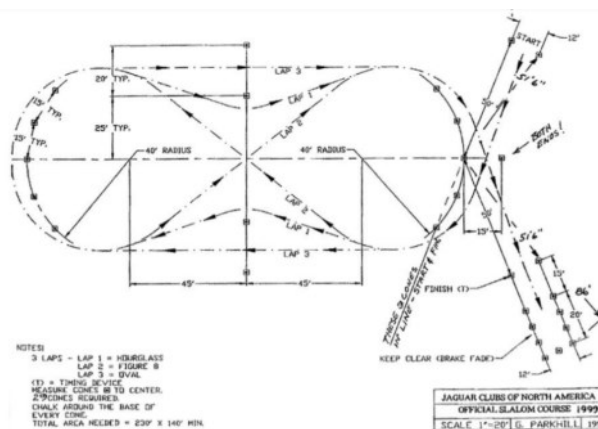


If it takes a village to raise a child, it certainly takes a city of CatDrivers to put on an International Jaguar Festival.

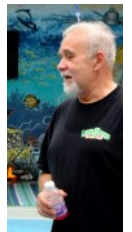

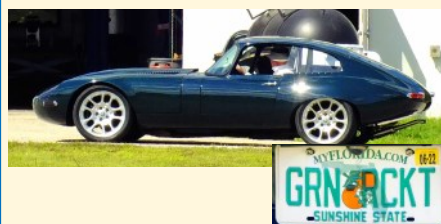

This year's runs took place again at the Lake County Tech Center in Tavares FL on Saturday, September 25th. Tom Wright III and Tom Wright did the required vehicle safety checks. This year's participating cars ranged from Toms Orlando's 1959 MG A to Juan Sierra's 2020 Lexus LS500.



WHAT? Those aren't Cats! Yes, they are... the bookends in age to the four F-Types, three XKs, and Britt Chapman's XJS, dating from 1988 to 2019. Ian Crawford began the day with his specially

modified XKE "Green Rocket," but he later drove off to return with last year's R-Class winning F-Type.



Prior to pressing the pedals, drivers used their feet to walk through the "Peanut, X, and Oval" course from start line to stop box.

Only one cone took a direct deforming hit! Not to fear, it later bounced back to shape.

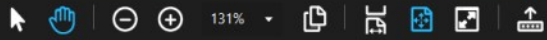

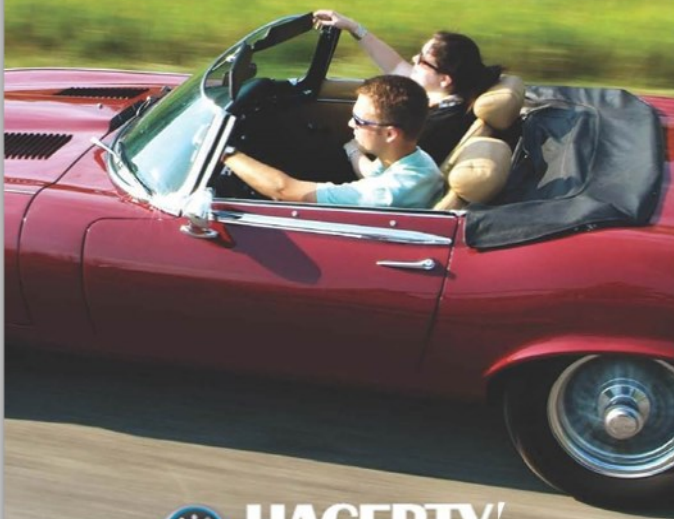
